Traditionally, schools tend to use particular teaching methods (either visual or aural, using books, CDs and written tests). Pupils who learn well with these styles are often seen as 'clever', while those who use different styles may find themselves in lower classes, labelled as 'slow learners'. In reality, they may be neither slow nor especially clever, but if they are treated differently, they may begin to believe the label that others put on them. But it doesn't have to be that way. Becoming more aware of your personal learning style can help you to take control of your learning by using techniques that work well for you. For example, here are some tips on how to adapt your study to your learning style:

Visual learners :

- Turn your notes into pictures , charts or diagrams.
- Don't have things around you that might distract your attention.
- Look at general ideas first before focusing on details.
- Use mind-maps, spider grams, etc instead of written notes .
